1. **Paperless:** Contribute via personal credit/debit card or electronic check directly from a bank account and choose a one-time or monthly gift. Print a copy of the completed Pledge Card for your records.
2. **Print & Submit:** For payroll deduction or cash/check gifts, complete an electronic Pledge Card and then print and submit it via the standard CFC-O representative chain of command.

**Rules:** No donation is necessary, but to enter the drawing to win the giveaway prizes, you must complete a Pledge Card. Only one entry per person is permitted. Special thanks to GEICO Insurance for donating the prizes. The odds of winning depend on the number of completed Pledge Cards received. The winners will be chosen in a random drawing of all entries received and notified by phone and/or in writing by April 30, 2011. The prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash. ## PRIVACY ACT NOTICE

Executive Order No. 12353 authorizes the U.S. Office of Personnel Management to conduct fundraising activities and to establish procedures for collecting information related to such activities.

Executive Order 9397 (November 22, 1943) authorizes the use of the Social Security Number (SSN). This collected information will be disclosed to organizations maintaining the accounting of contributions and to your payroll office.

Additional disclosure may be made to the Department of Treasury to make proper financial adjustments to a court of another agency when the government is party to a suit; and to the Internal Revenue Service and state and local taxing authorities regarding income tax returns.

The furnishing of the SSN, along with other data requested, is voluntary. However, failure to furnish any of the requested information may result in errors or noncompliance with your request for a payroll allotment by your agency.

If you are making a one-time, lump-sum gift and, therefore, not using the payroll allotment method of payment, you are not required to furnish your SSN.
