According to the Environmental Protection Agency, U.S. residents and businesses produced more than 243 million tons of trash in 2009—approximately 4.3 pounds of waster per person per day. We recycled and composted about 82 million tons of this material, equivalent to a 33.8% recycling rate. Every ton of mixed paper recycled can save the energy equivalent of 165 gallons of gasoline and every ton of aluminum cans saves 1,665 gallons of gasoline!
